Austria & Medicine



The Medical University of Vienna celebrated its 10th anniversary as an independent university, separate from the University of Vienna, in 2014. So it is one of the youngest universities, but at the same time it can point to a tradition going back many centuries: From the Medical School of the Middle Ages to an ultra-modern research location.

- Earliest Evidence from the Middle Ages: Medical School founded in 1365
- The “Wiener (Medizinische) Schule” in the Imperial Capital
 - First “Wiener Schule” – Gerard van Swieten, Leopold von Auenbrugger
 - Second “Wiener Schule” – Carl von Rokitansky, Josef von Škoda, Ignaz Semmelweis, Theodor Billroth, Julius Wagner-Jauregg, Carl Landsteiner, Clemens von Pirquet ...
 - the birthplace of specialised medicine
- Cutting Edge Medicine in the 20th Century
- 1938: Turning Point in History
- 1945: Reconstruction of Society and Medicine
- 1994: The new Vienna General Hospital, now Europe’s largest University Hospital
- 2004: New Beginning – a modern research institution, employing a staff of 5,500 (3,600 academic; 1,600 medical doctors)

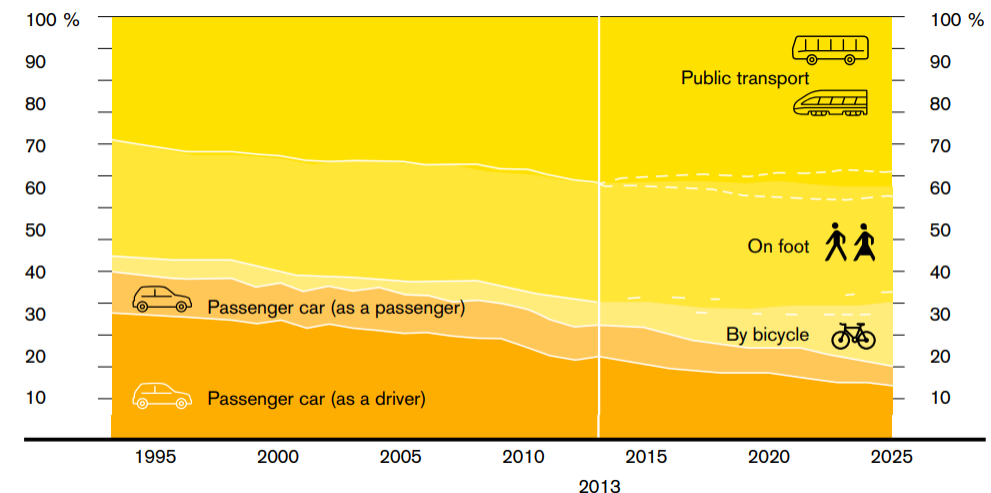


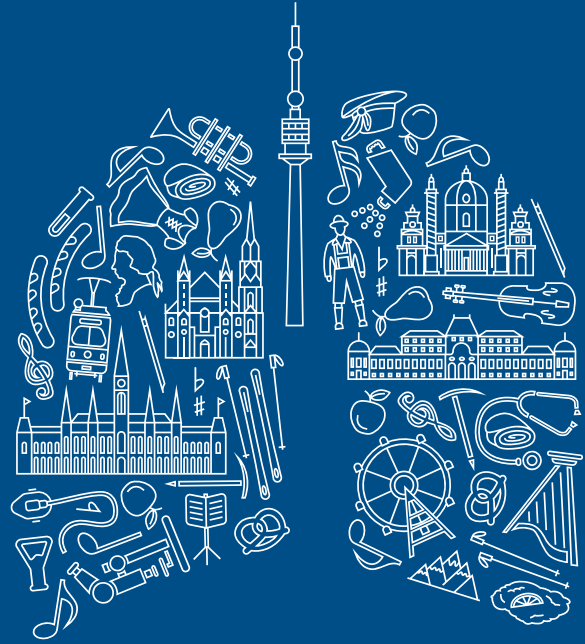
Green Vienna – Clean Air

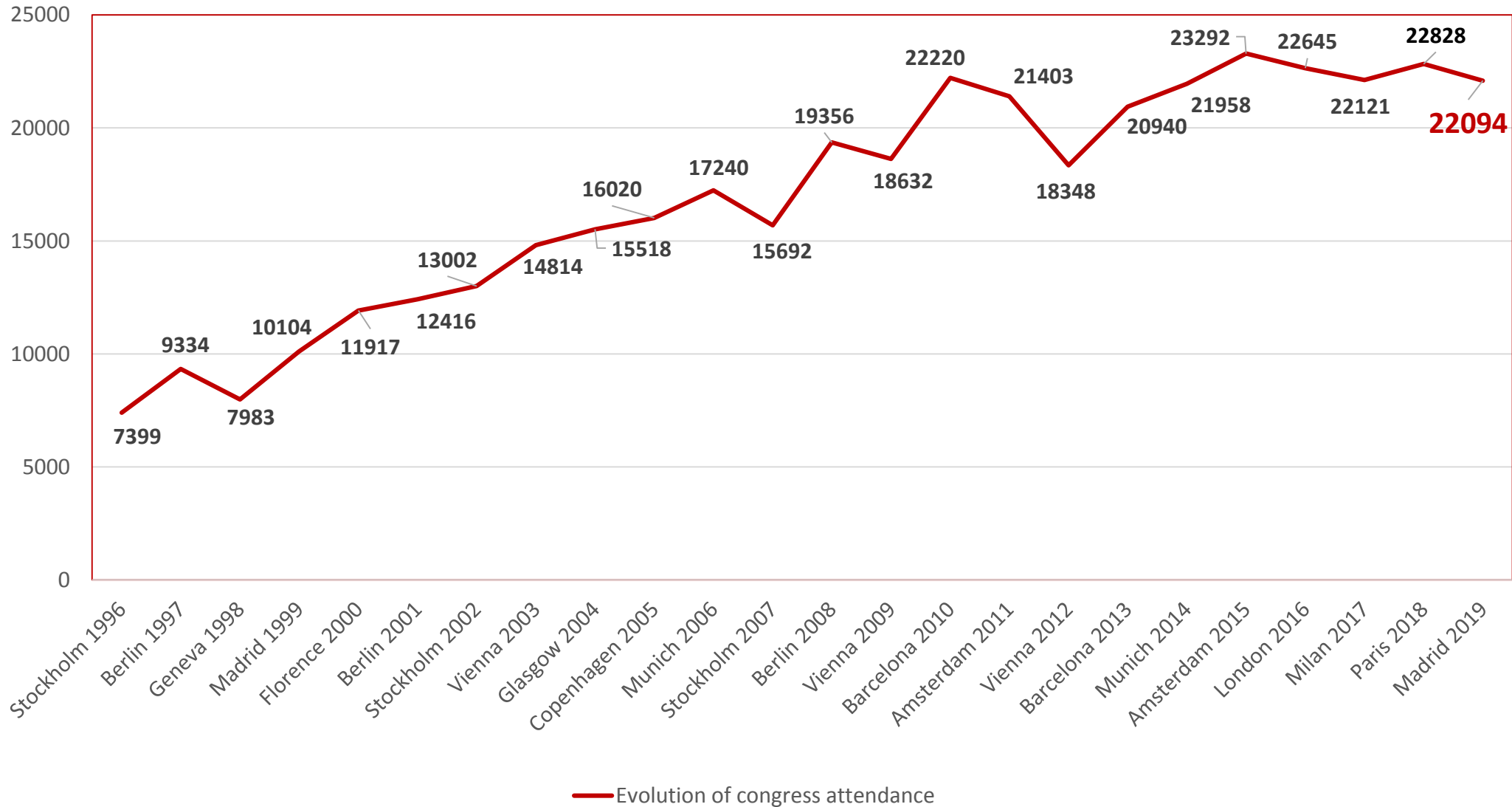

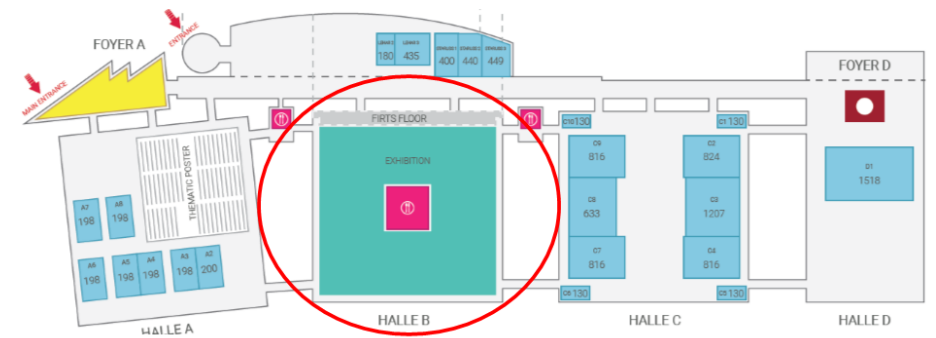

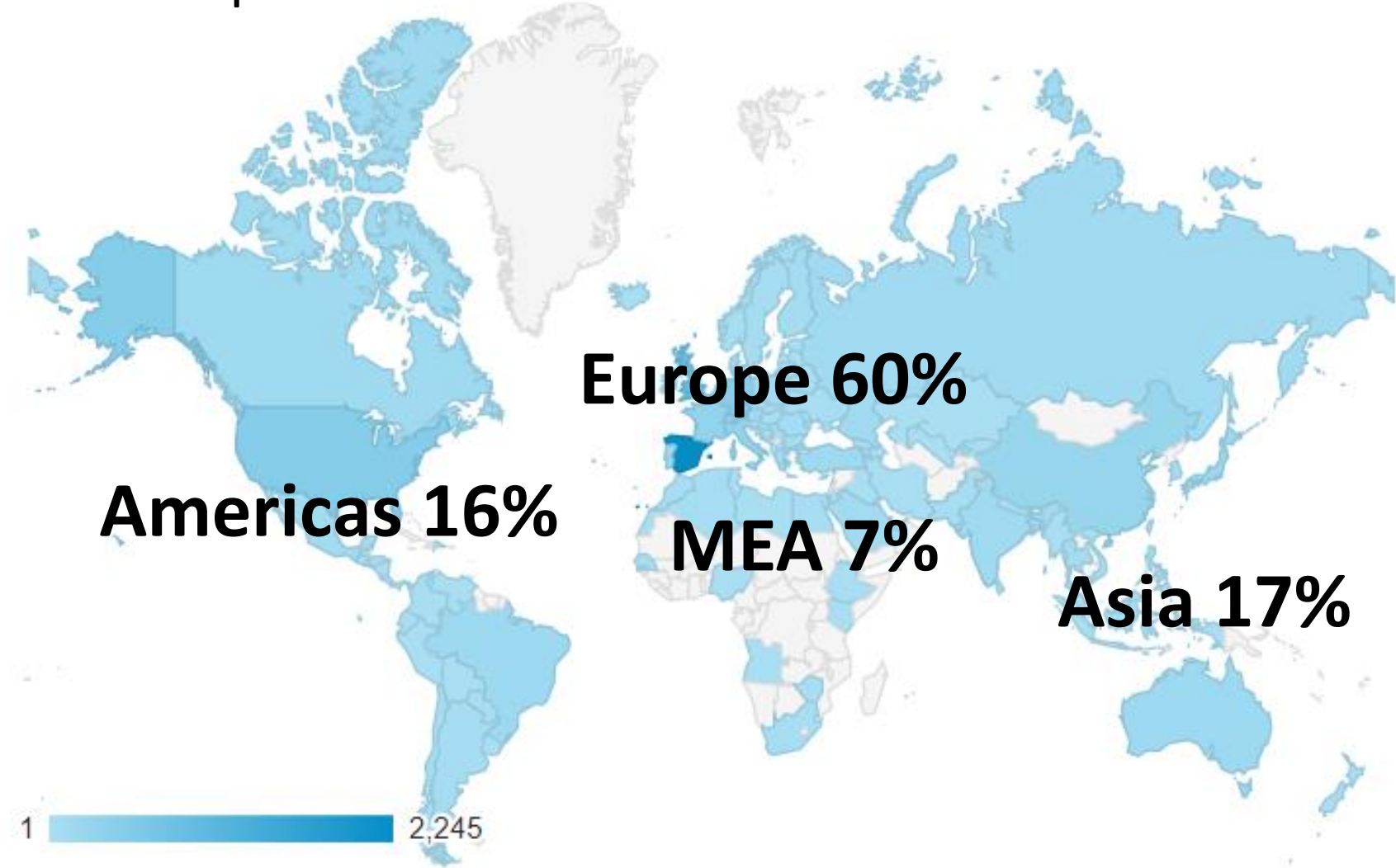

Construction rules

Heights:

2,5m at the edge

4,5m if 50cm inside the stand

6m: unbranded / uncladded riggings for technical use only

Transparency:

As open as possible!

Not more than 70% of the view from one side to the other should be blocked.

Depth of hanging banners going around the stand max. 1m.

Banners facing direct neighbors shall not be branded.

Rear and side walls must be completely closed, white, uncabled and clean on the sides facing neighbors.

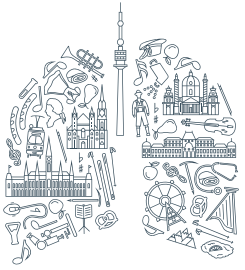


Stand approval procedure

1. Hand in your project to Kristof Kemp until 03 July
2. Kristof Kemp/Oliver Heinke will check ERS construction / design rule compliance
3. If OK we send official approval email

Attention! ERS does not check compliance with the Reed Messe Vienna construction rules. Make sure to read their regulations (available on the Exhibitor Service Center) thoroughly and plan accordingly!

Certificates validating fire proofness of construction materials are necessary and will be controlled during set-up! For complex rigging structures with many motors and heavy weights we strongly recommend to appoint a structural engineer.

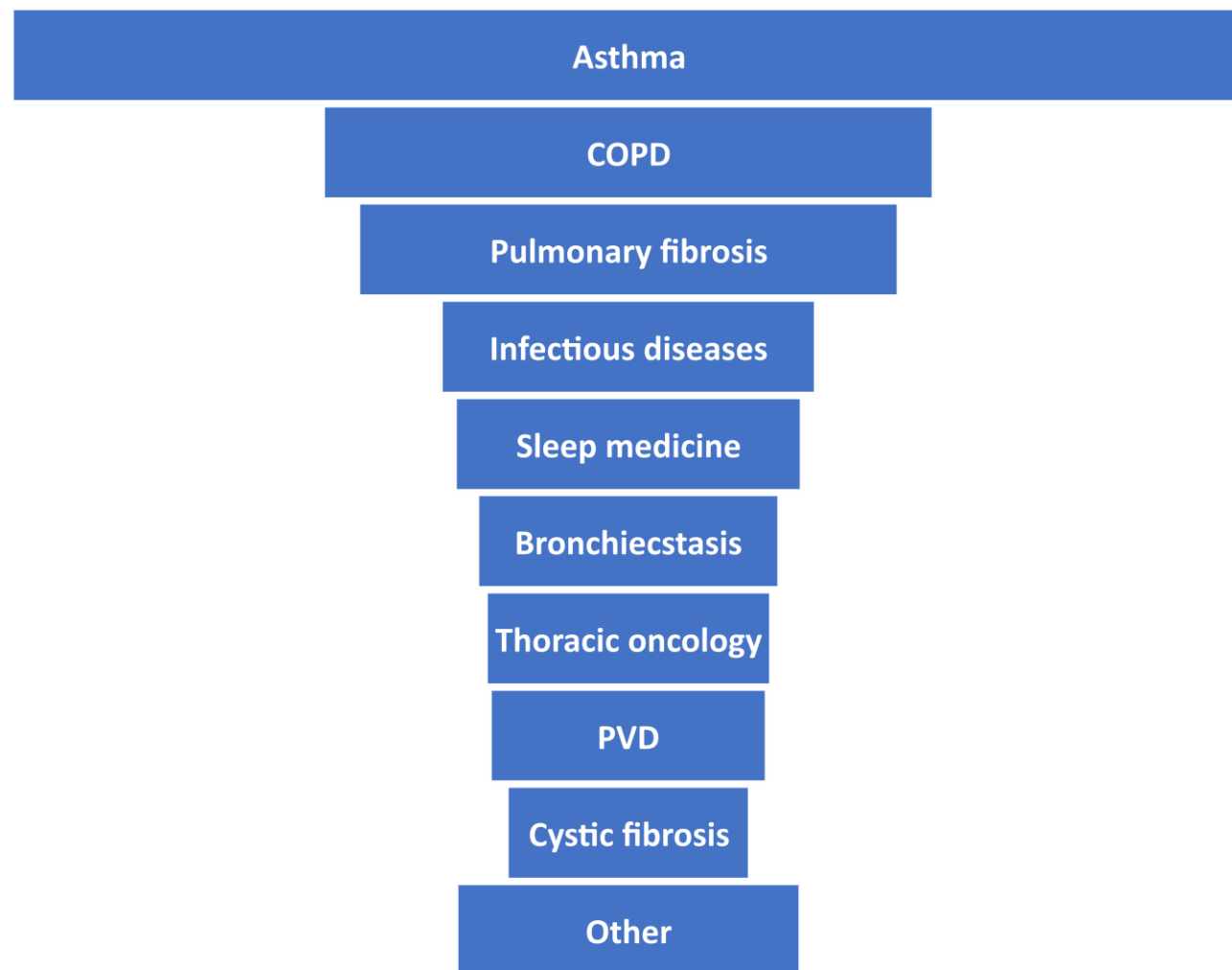

MAIN PROFESSION OF PARTICIPANTS



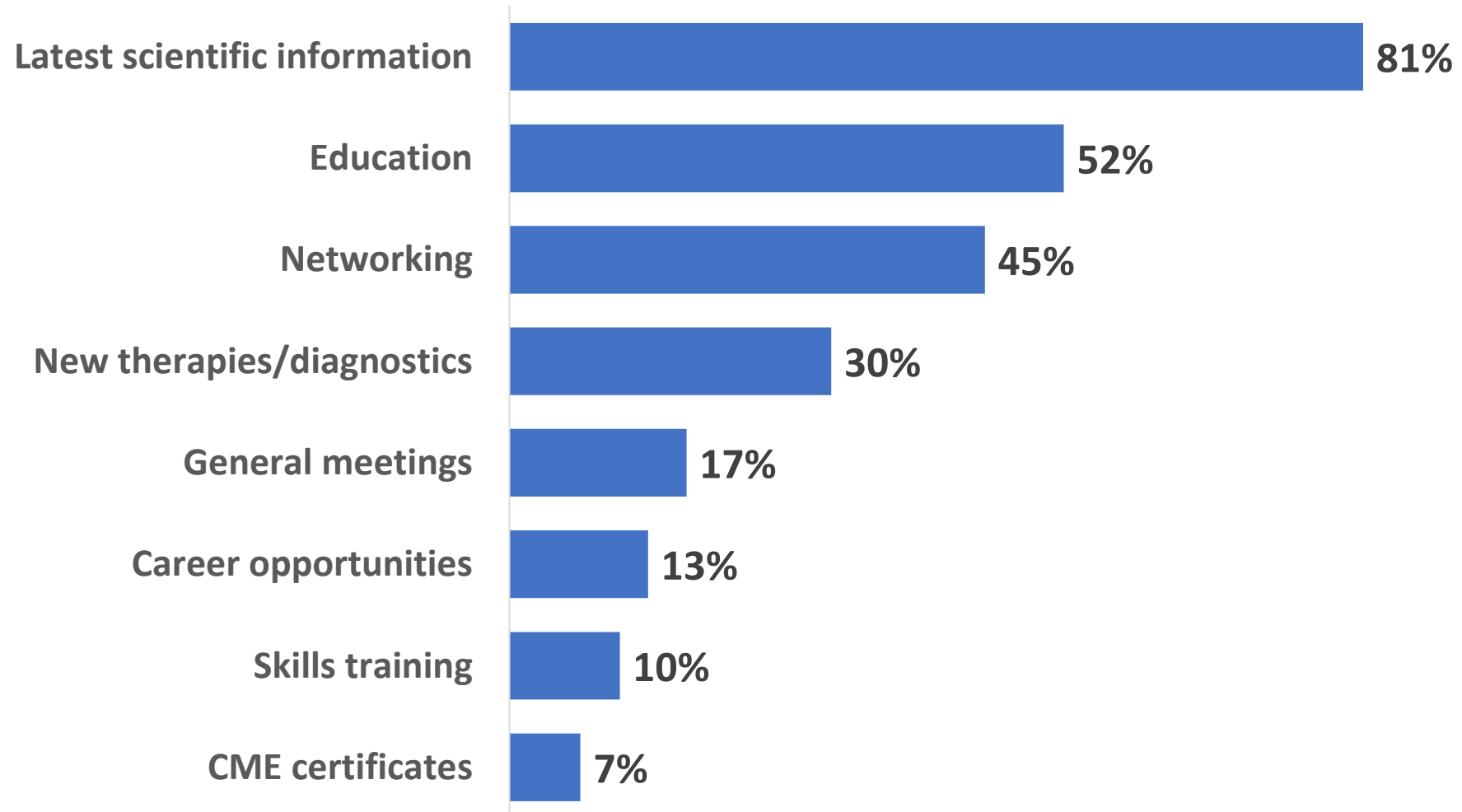

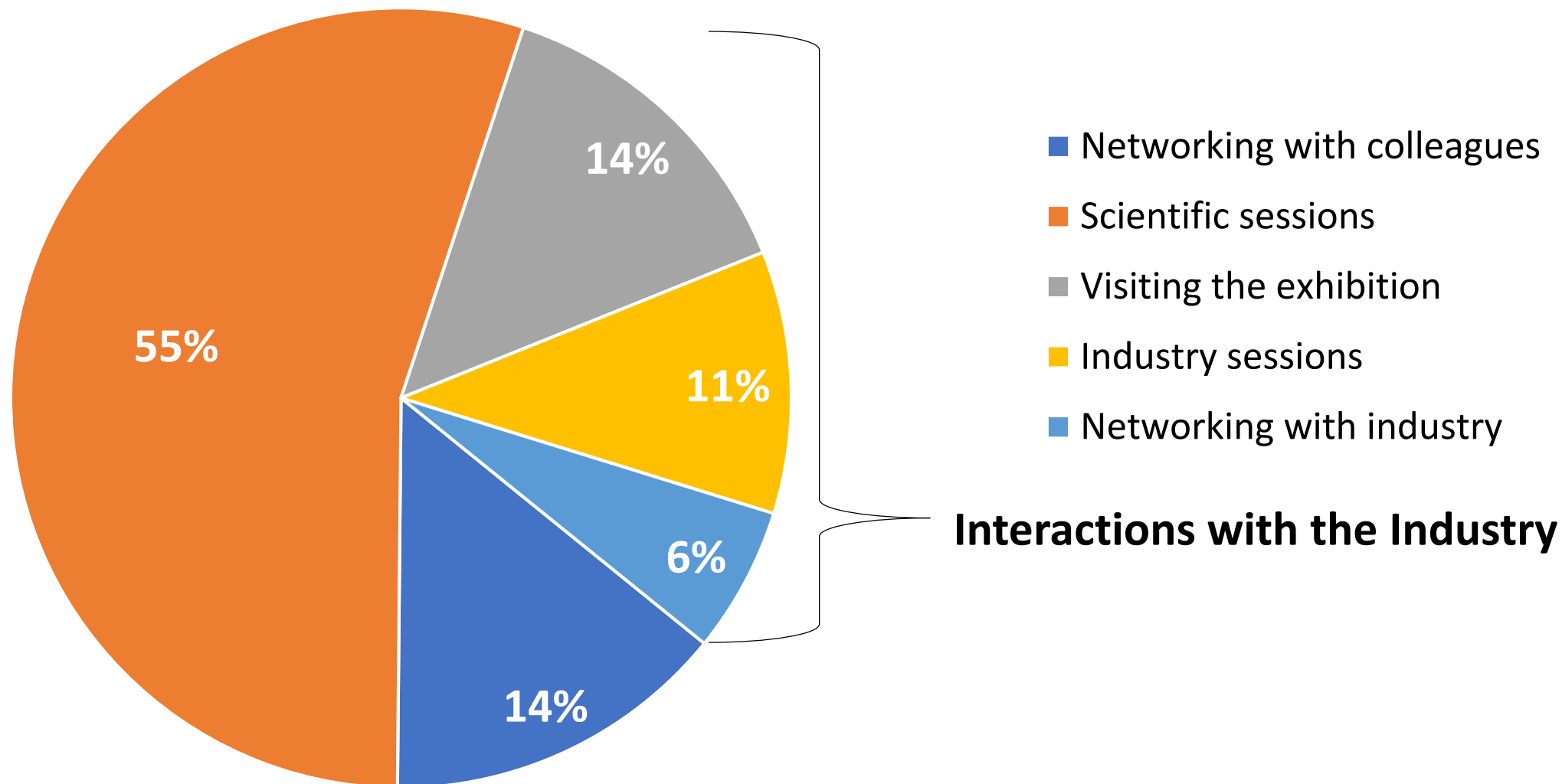

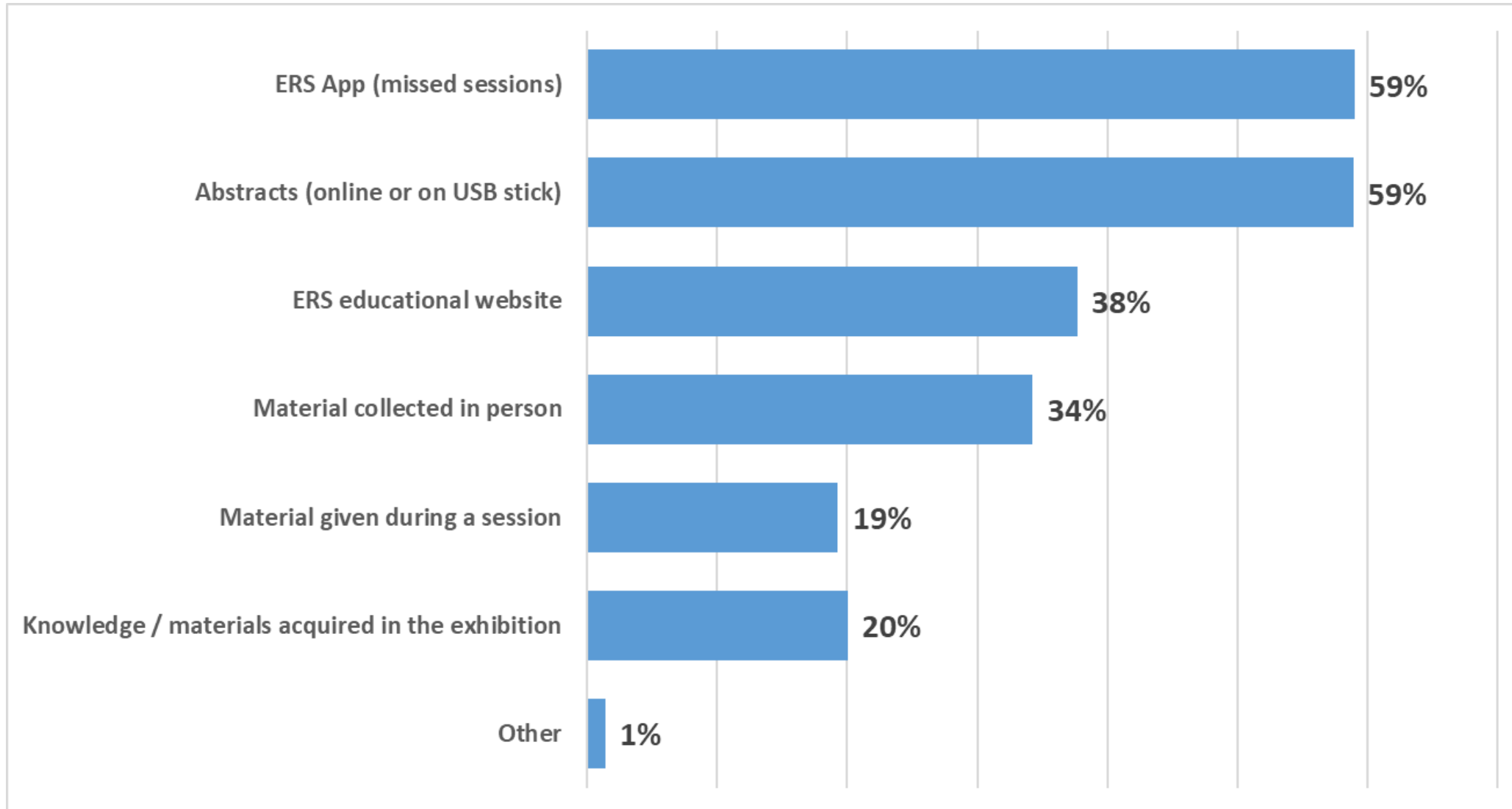

Structure of a delegate's day



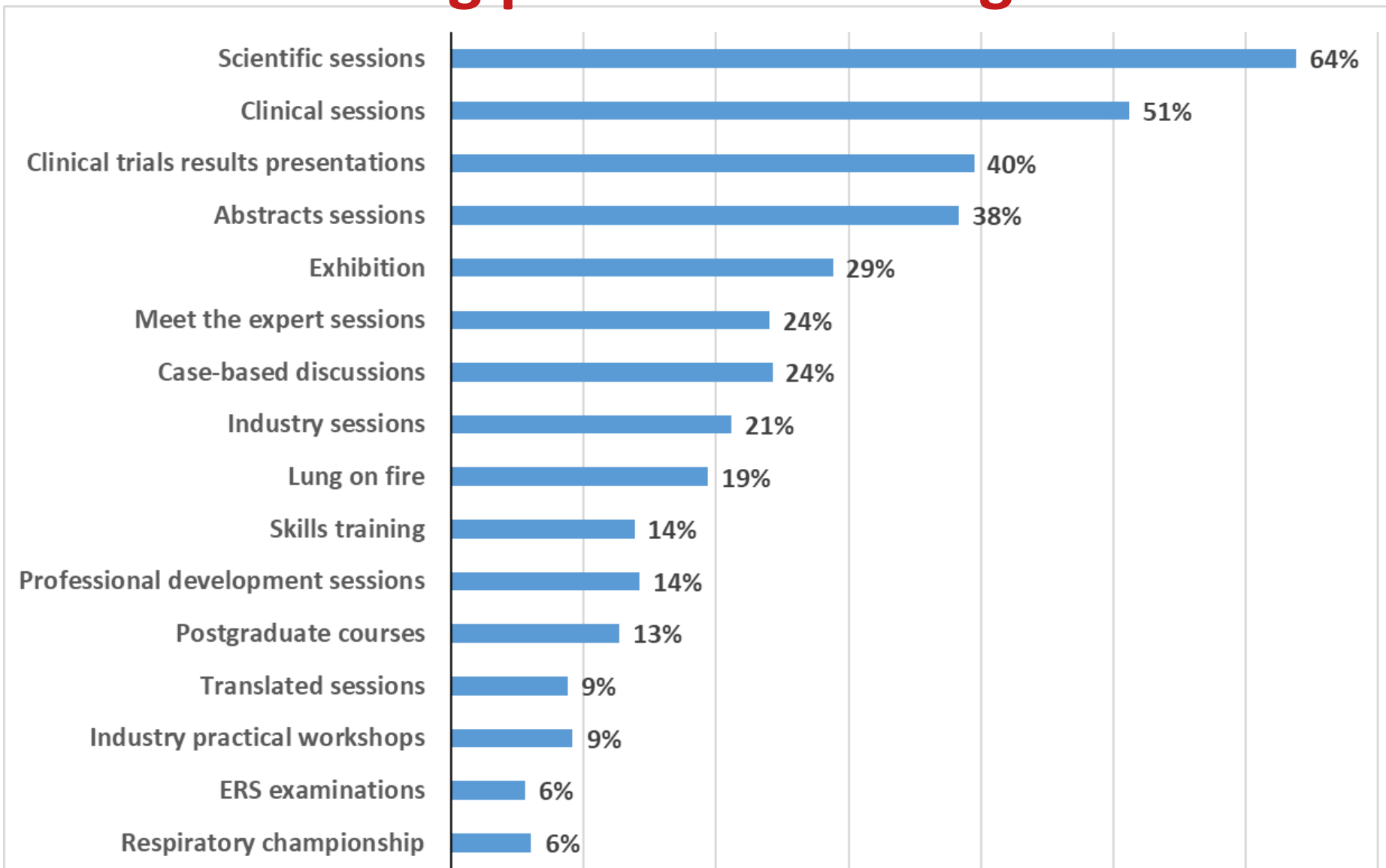

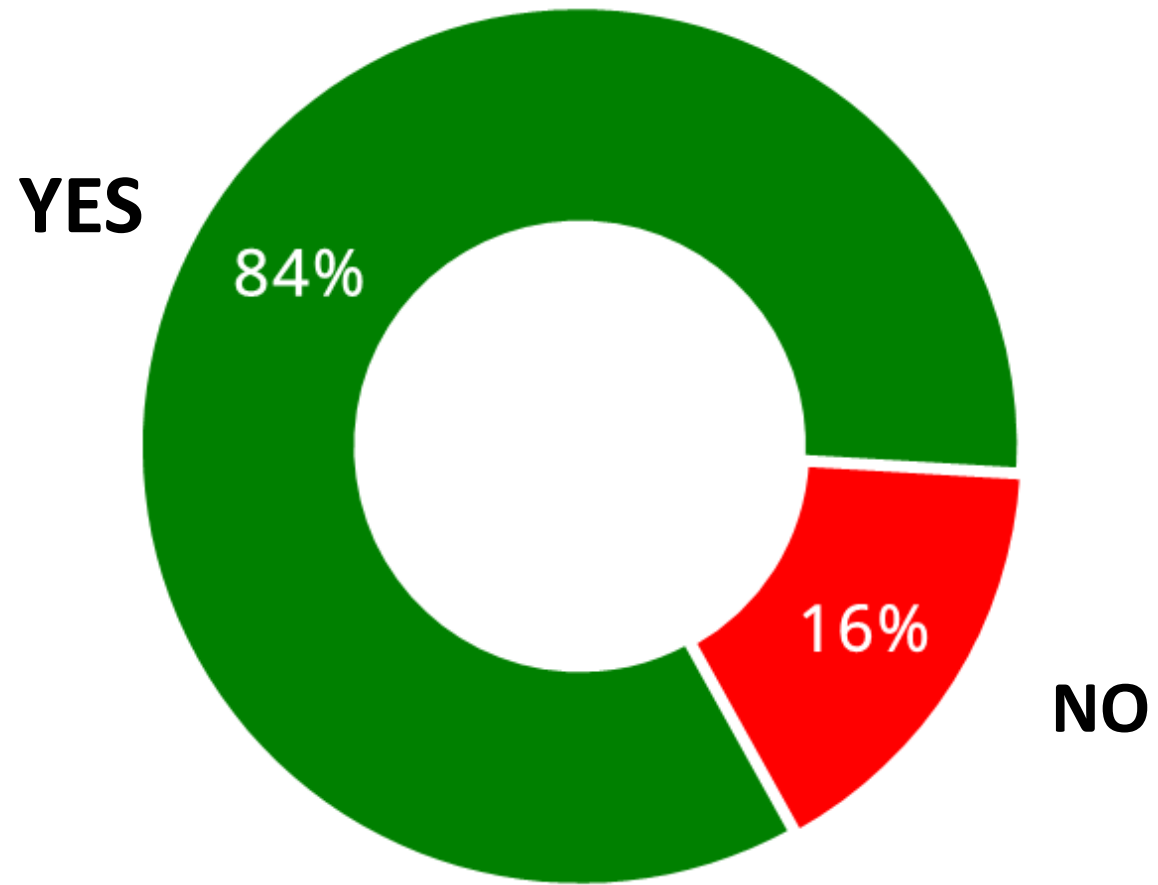

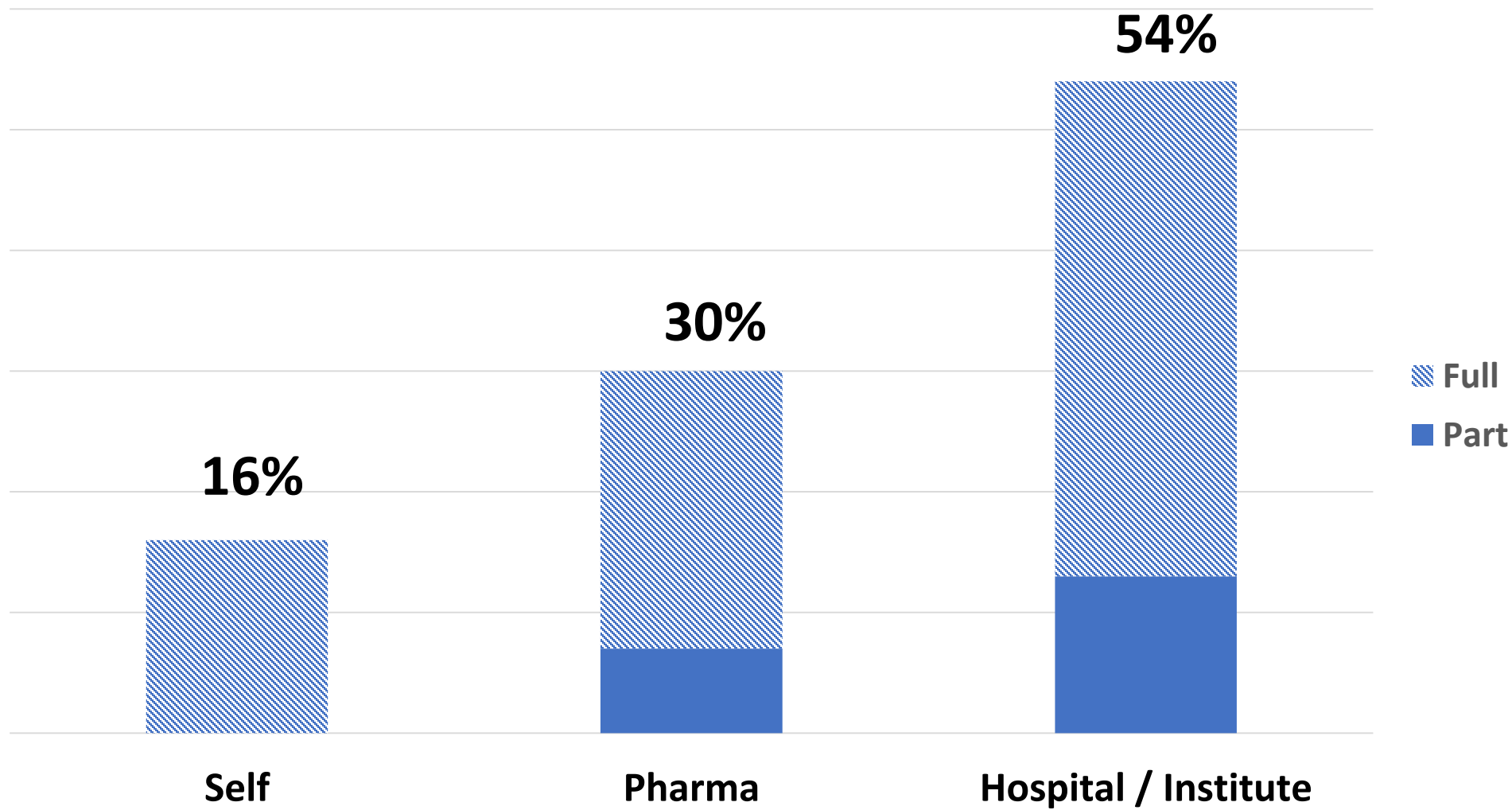

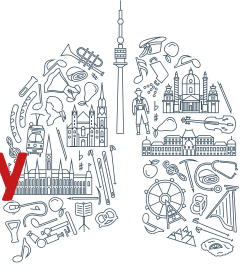


Outstanding & recurring comments from the Exhibition survey



- **Scanners did not work properly or were too slow (camera not focusing with the dim lights)**
- **Pulmonary Pavilion was a good initiative but needs more advertising**

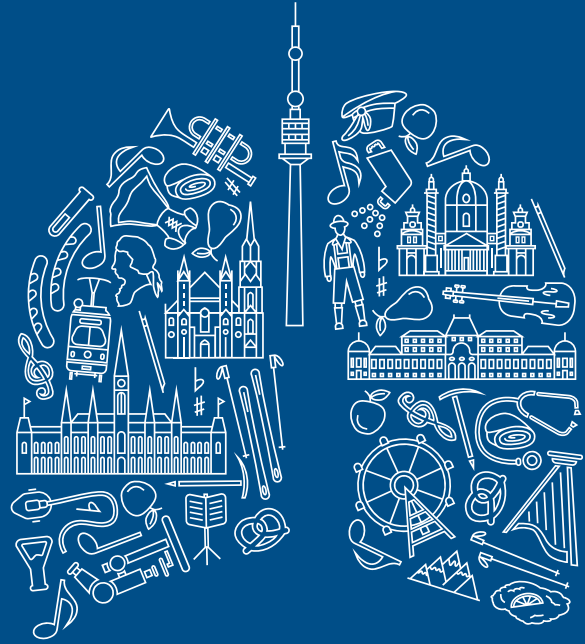
